COURSE OVERVIEW

Students will learn how to safely handle and manage livestock. Students will become familiar with operating a range of different machinery; including tractors. The course is designed to equip students with the basic skills and knowledge required to assist on a working farm. As part of their studies, students participate on regular trips to farming operations around the Geelong region. This VET Agriculture course is made up of has approximately 50% theory and 50% practical.
