COURSE OVERVIEW

Students will learn how to recognise a range of plants, how to successfully plant and propagate, perform garden maintenance and how to test and sample soils. Students will become familiar with operating a range of different machinery; including tractors. The course is designed to equip students with the basic skills and knowledge required to work within the horticulture industry. As part of their studies, students participate on regular trips to horticulture businesses around the Geelong region. This VET Horticulture course is made up of approximately 50% theory and 50% practical.

This course also provides credit towards VCE VM requirements.
